- Increase spaces for the voices of children, young people and their families to be heard in order to increase their influence on service delivery and design
- Increase our organisational capacity to adopt a rights-based approach when supporting children, young people, and their families
- A reduction in language and practises that children and young people find stigmatizing
- Develop, increase, and sustain collaborative working relationships across the care sector
