Recovery is a journey we take together.

At Beechwood House, we understand that it can be a difficult and anxious time when you make the first step towards recovery.

Staff are available 24hrs a day, 7 days a week to support you through every aspect of your journey, from the initial contact and assessment phase through to commencing your support.

We will help you to choose a programme that is right for you, based on your needs and aspirations.

Beechwood has a supportive, skilled and knowledgeable staff team. You will be assigned an experienced key worker to work with you on your own individual recovery plan including a Recovery exit plan implemented before discharge.

Beechwood Programmes

If you decide to we are the right service for you, the next step is a referral (usually completed by your Health or Social Care worker). We will arrange an assessment to make sure we understand your aspirations and support needs.

We offer

- 2 14 week programme
- Community Outreach Support
- 3 month aftercare support following completion of long programme
