Child Focused Therapeutic Support

We work with children aged between 5 to 18 within the City of Edinburgh who are affected by drug or alcohol use in their families.

At Sunflower Garden, children benefit from having a safe and confidential space where they can explore their emotions, thoughts and feelings whilst developing positive coping strategies.

We understand that the support we provide needs to be specific to the needs of each child. We offer a range of tailored supports such as:

- Counselling (including art and play therapy)
- One-to-one therapeutic support in schools
- Group work

All our work is aimed to support your child in the best way possible.
