

Guidance for Executors

How can I be sure the gift is meant for CrossReach?

If you are acting as an Executor, you will know a gift in a Will is for us if it contains some or all of the following information:

- 'CrossReach', the 'Board of Social Responsibility', 'Church of Scotland Social Care Council', 'Eventide Homes' or other variation of our name or social care purpose appears in the Will.
- CrossReach shares its registered charity number SC011353 with the Church of Scotland. This number should appear in the Will.
- Our current or a previous Central Office address appears in the Will, or the address of one of our services.
- If you are still unsure you should consider whether there was a history of long-term support for CrossReach by the person who made the Will.

How do I pay in a legacy cheque?

Please make cheques payable to 'CrossReach', mark for the attention of the Legacy Team and send to CrossReach, Charis House, 47 Milton Road East, Edinburgh EH15 2SR. If you'd prefer to make a payment by means other than cheque, please get in touch with us on 0131 454 4374.

When you send a legacy cheque, we'd be really grateful if you could also include:

- The full name and title of the deceased
- Their last address this will also allow us to prevent any future mailings as we know this can be distressing at a difficult time
- The date of death
- The Executor's name and contact details
- A copy of the Will
- Any information about the reason for the legacy.

Please note: your details as Executor will not be added to any mailing lists as a result of contacting us about a legacy.
