

Legacy: FAQs

It is important that you seek proper legal advice when making your Will; however here are answers to some frequently-asked questions.

Can I update my Will to include CrossReach?

Yes. You can add a codicil for any minor changes to your Will, including the addition of a charity. When you speak to your solicitor they will advise you if a codicil is the best option. If there are several changes to make, it may be more appropriate to re-write your Will.

Will my gift be taxed?

No. Gifts to charities are exempt from Inheritance Tax and may reduce any liability for tax on the rest of your estate. For more information, visit the HM Revenue & Customs website page gov.uk/donating-to-charity/leaving-gifts-to-charity-in-your-will.

Can I specify how I would like my gift to be used?
